## 2019 Parent Term Overview: Year 5 – Term 1

Key Learning Areas – Overview of Expected Outcomes		Assessment Items (subject to change)
<b>English</b>	<p>Throughout the term, students will be reading and analysing the fantasy novel: Deltora Quest – The Forests of Silence, to identify and explain the text structures and language features used by the author to create their characters. They will demonstrate their understanding by writing their own timed narrative.</p> <p>During literacy and language activities the students will be engaging in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Phonetic and spelling activities – using different spelling patterns, especially multisyllabic words (e.g.: loneliness, whistling and previously)</li> <li>✓ Explicit spelling instruction – daily practise using the THRASS chart for words such as those which have complex consonants (st: castle and hustle and sw: answer and sword)</li> <li>✓ Paragraph structure – how to write a TEEL paragraph (topic, explanation, evidence and link)</li> <li>✓ Writing activities – building up to writing their own narrative in an allocated timeframe</li> </ul> <p><b>Vocabulary to learn:</b> thronging, roused, sorely, mingled, trundling, traitor and parchment.</p>	<p><b>Week 7:</b> Comprehending an unknown short text in a given time frame</p> <p><b>Week 8:</b> Timed narrative writing</p>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<p>Through daily practise, games, investigations and explicit instruction the students will be learning how to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Identify and describe factors of whole numbers and use them to solve problems</li> <li>✓ Use efficient mental and written strategies</li> <li>✓ Solve problems involving multiplication and division of large numbers by one or two digits</li> <li>✓ Calculate the area and perimeter of rectangle</li> <li>✓ Compare 12 and 24 hour time systems and convert between them</li> <li>✓ Describe and interpret different sets, including dot plots and tables.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Week 5:</b> Fantastic factors and magnificent multiples</p> <p><b>Week 8:</b> Digging into data</p>
